Examination Rules for Years 10, 11 and 12 Students

The following rules are to be observed by all students in relation to school-based examinations. Students should read them carefully prior to attending any examination. These rules should be read in conjunction with the relevant BBHS and NESAs assessment policies.

1. You have the responsibility to know your examination timetable and to be at the right place at the right time. You must be at the examination room 10 minutes before the scheduled start. Misreading a timetable is not a valid excuse and no additional time will be given.
2. You must supply your own equipment, including pens, a calculator and any other specified items. Calculators must be of an approved type (if in doubt, check with your Mathematics teacher). Lined paper or exam booklets are provided for all exams. No paper may be taken into or from the examination.
3. Only approved equipment can be taken your desk. No folders, books or personal items (except drinking water) are permitted. When in the MPC, bags and other equipment should be left on the eastern side of the room.
4. Mobile phones or other electronic devices must be switched off and placed in bags or surrendered prior to entering the examination room. If any examination is interrupted by a mobile phone, the bag/phone will be confiscated.
5. Do not talk after entering the examination room unless speaking to a teacher. You may not communicate in any way with another student. This includes turning around, gesturing or borrowing equipment. If you have any requests or problems, raise your hand and wait for a teacher.
6. You are not permitted to leave exams early with the exception of the Trial HSC. You must remain seated until all papers are collected. If other examinations are still underway, leave quietly and take care not to disturb anyone else. During the Trial HSC, you may not leave in the first hour or last 15 minutes of the examination.
7. If you need a toilet break during an exam, you need to ask for permission from a teacher. Normally, there is no toilet access during the last 10 minutes of an exam.
8. Cheating or malpractice in any form is a serious offence. You must actively ensure that your conduct in the examination room is honest and that any of your actions cannot be construed as cheating.
9. Examinations are considered as a normal school activity. Standard school rules apply and school uniform must be worn. Hooded jumpers and other headwear not permitted.
10. If you are unable to sit an examination due to illness or misadventure you must contact the school as soon as possible. Refer to the school policy for assessment appeals.

For school-based examinations, you are required to bring your student identification card (ID) and have it visible on your desk for attendance marking procedures.

Breaching any of the examination rules may result in removal from the examination room and a mark of zero being awarded. Further disciplinary action may be taken. Examinations are treated as assessment tasks and the same conditions apply.
