Enrolments are accepted at any time of the year via appointment with the principal. Limited places are available to out of area enrolments (note some elective classes may be full).

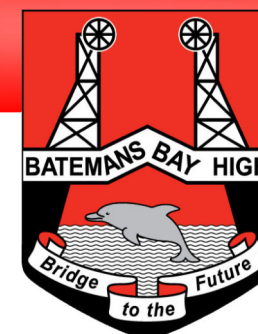
