## Batemans Bay High School ICT Acceptable Use Agreement- Network and Internet

The school is equipped with a number of computer rooms and banks of laptops in various Faculty areas which are accessed by all students for educational purposes. Students are expected to be responsible users of the internet and technology. Upon enrolment parents/carers are required to agree to the conditions of acceptable use by signing this form. Failure to return the completed form may result in suspension of the student's computer account access.

There are sufficient ICT facilities for all students at Batemans Bay High School. However, if families allow a student to bring a device to school, the device is the responsibility of the student. BYO Devices can be connected to the schools computer network.

Students are expected to use the school's ICT facilities in a responsible, efficient, ethical and legal manner. Failure to use ICT facilities responsibly will result in the loss of access privileges and may result in payment for damages or other disciplinary action, in line with the School's Discipline Procedures.

The school maintains a website (www.batemansba-h.schools.nsw.gov.au) and a Facebook page and with parental permission, publishes student work and photos. It is Department of Education policy that no student will be identified by full name and no student's contact details will be published. If you do not wish your child's photo to be published, please indicate this on the enrolment form.

Cyber safety for students is an important aspect of this agreement and imbedded in our ICT policy, below is a list of possible breaches of this agreement.

Unacceptable uses of the Internet and/or the school network include:

- Logging on under any name other than your own.
- Letting another student use your password.
- Degrading or disrupting school equipment, software or system performance.
- Invading the privacy of individuals and/or vandalising the data of another user.
- Using the network for any illegal activity, including violation of copyright or plagiarism.
- Non-educational Internet use...specifically downloading and storing non-educational material.
- Searching, retrieving, storing, displaying, printing or transferring obscene or offensive material.
- Bullying or harassing other students.
